Our student art workshops have ended for this year and we're working on next year's offerings. This year we served 1,055 students (690 in-house; 365

outreach), 29 classes with 11 bus trips. We're up 200 students with our overall total.

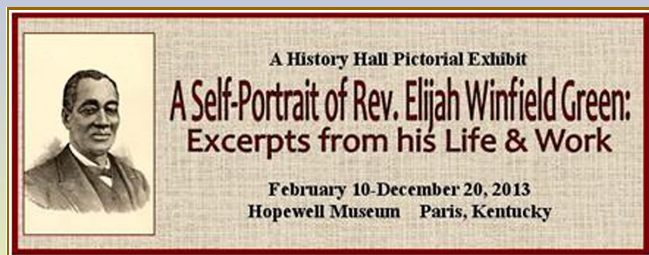
