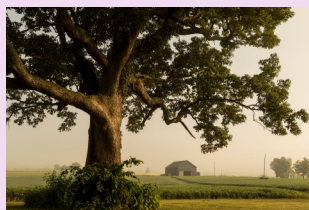

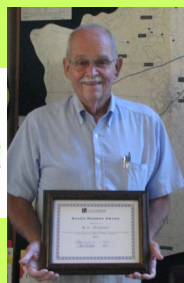


## Annual Fund Drive Nov. 1 to Dec. 31

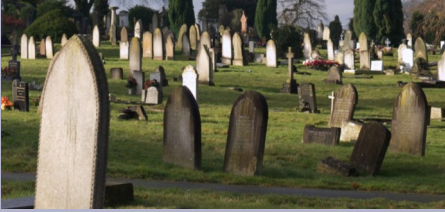

## Terra Cotta Restoration Campaign

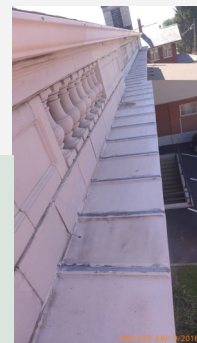
