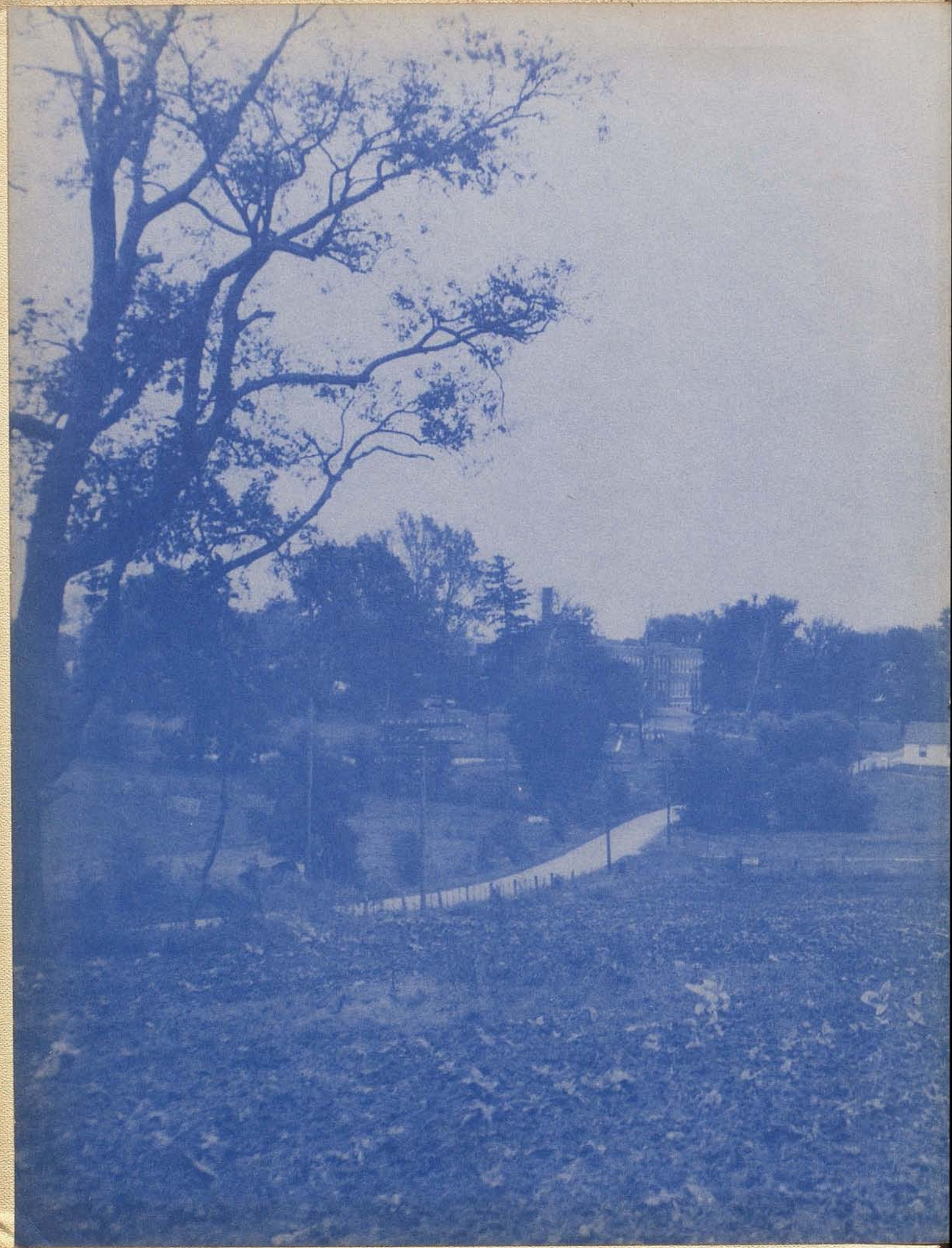

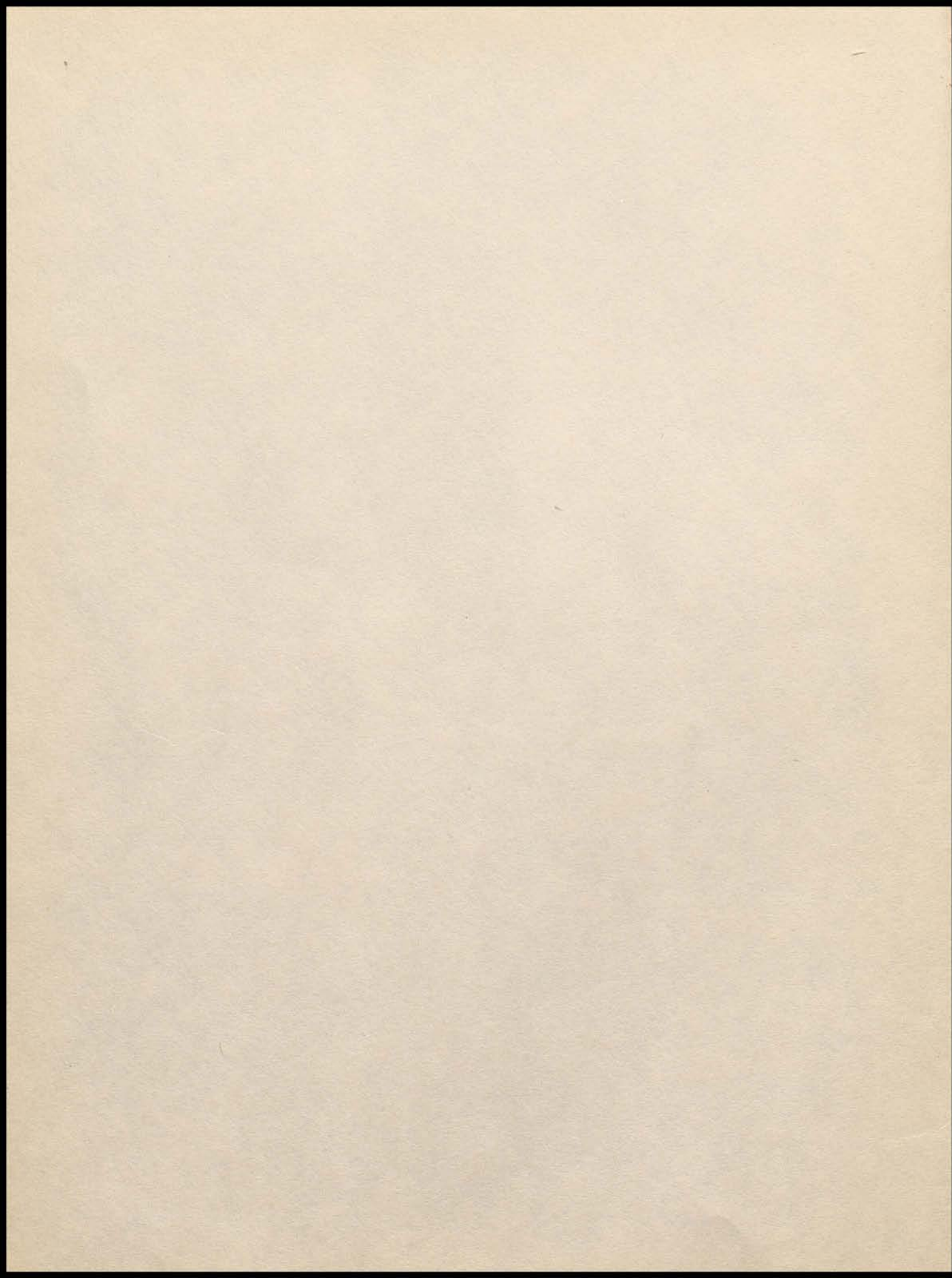


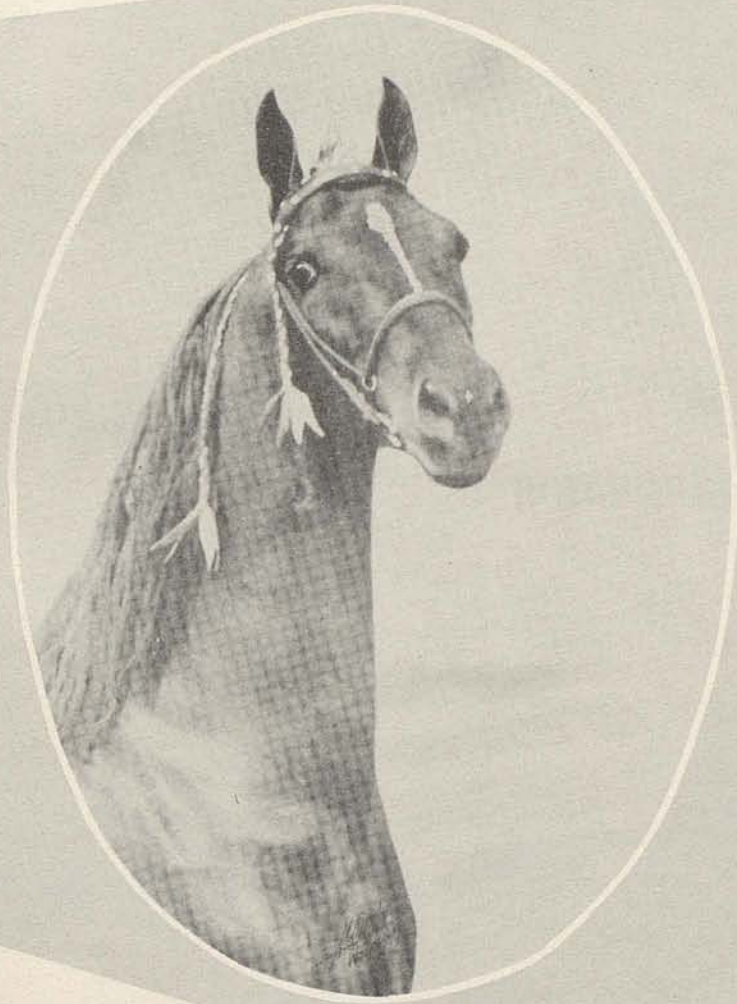

EARNEST H. DARNABY

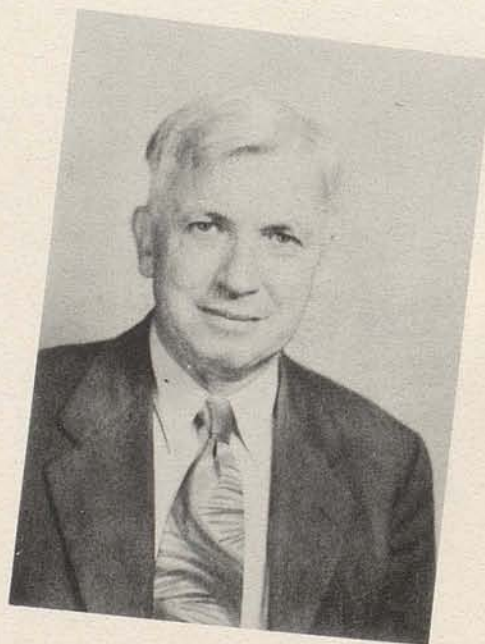
Superintendent of Bourbon county schools since 1939, holds A.B. and M.A. degrees from the University of Kentucky.
