I will be back by and by.

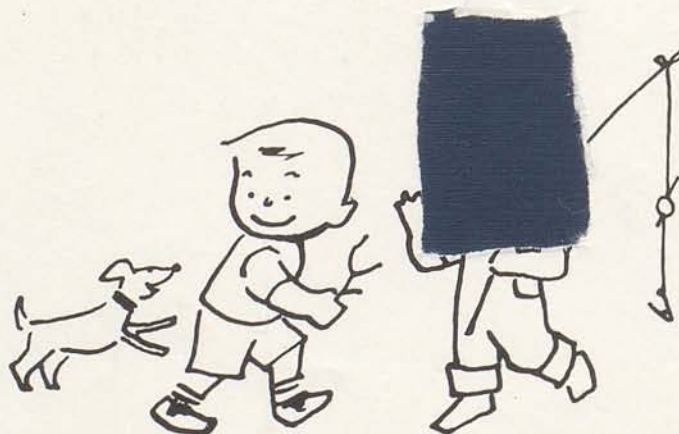
