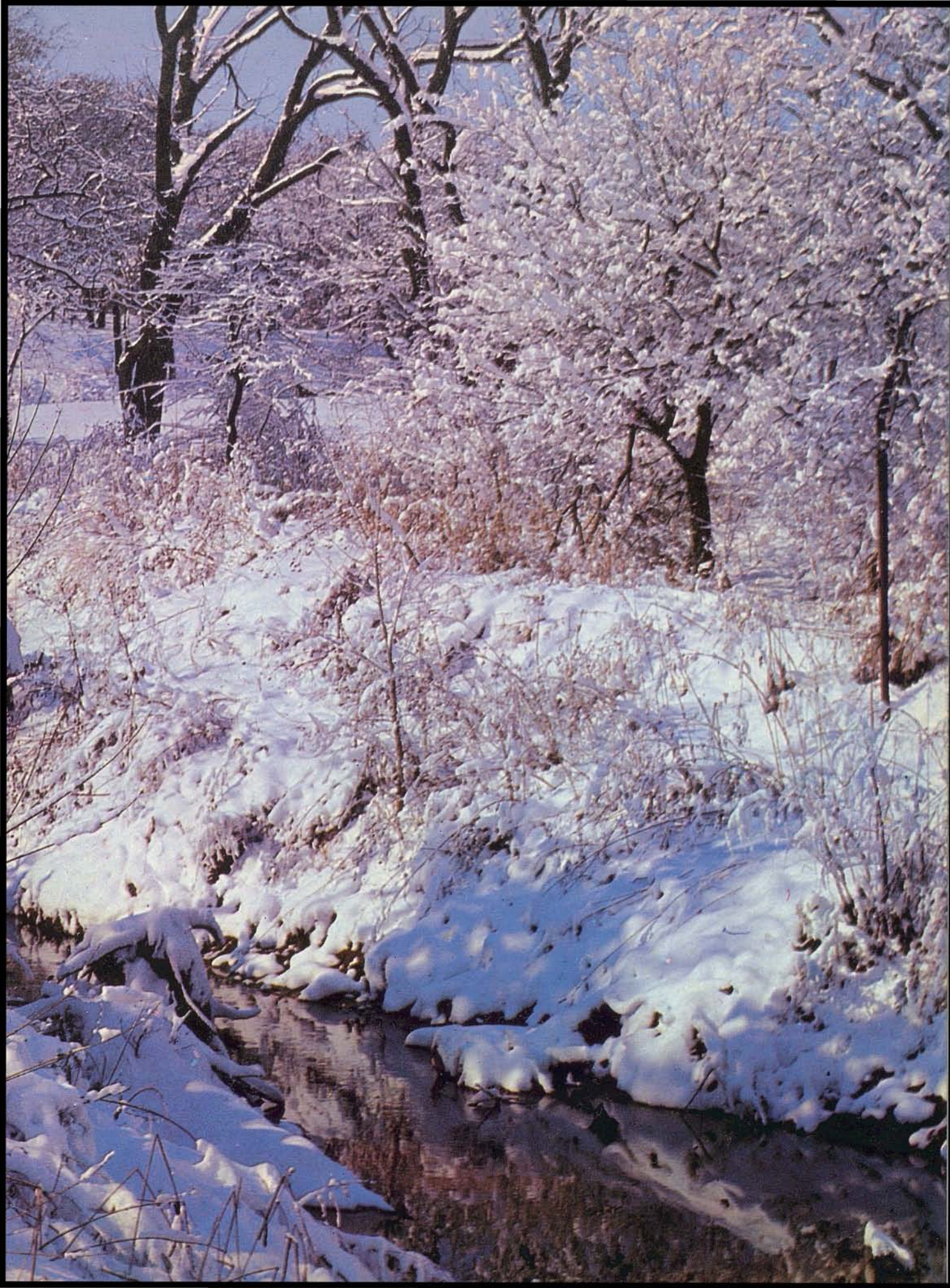
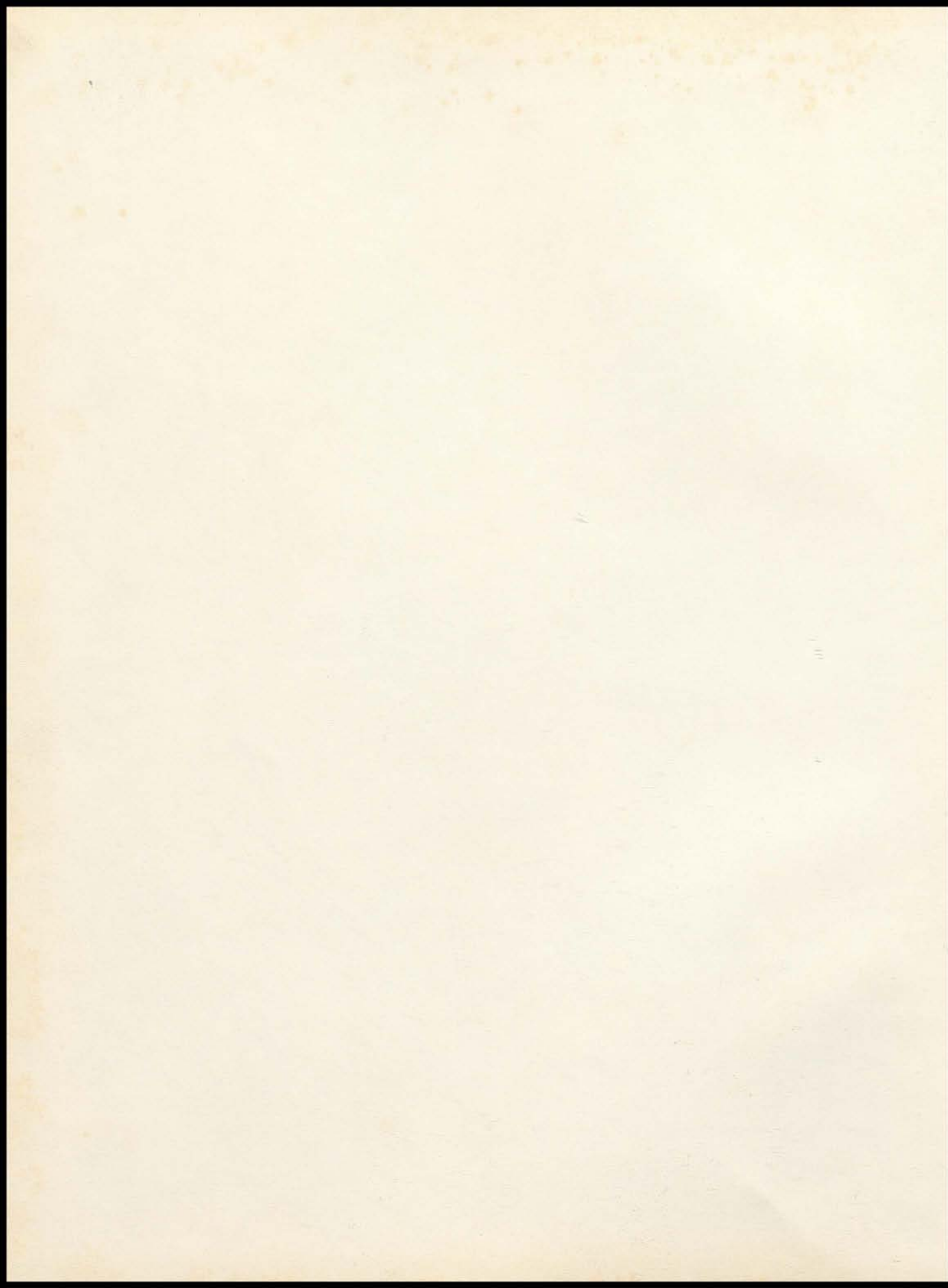

FOREWORD


As we, the youth of today face this vastly troubled world with which we must soon begin to cope, we can surely say that our high school days will be regarded as the most carefree.
