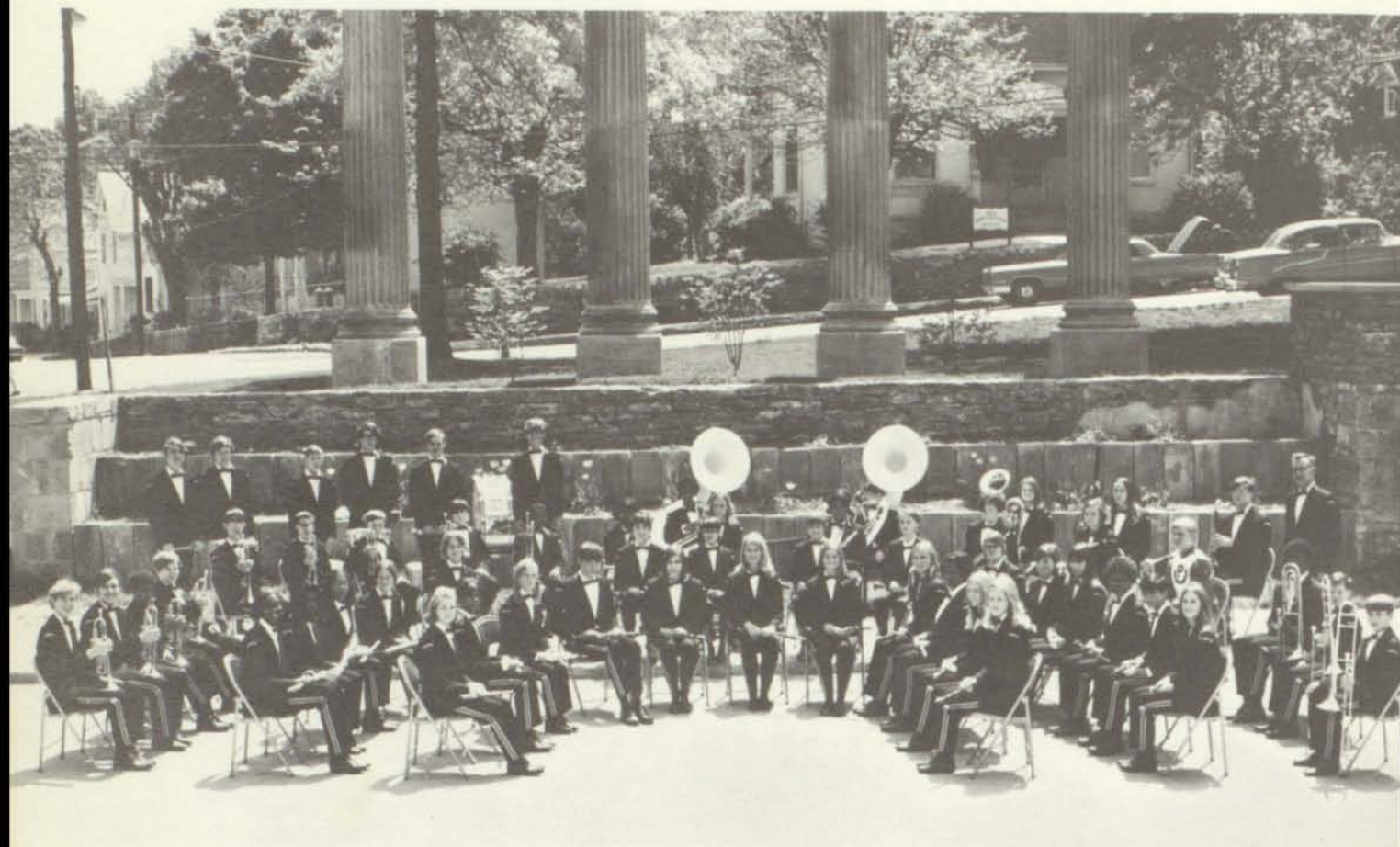


The Senior Class of 1971 dedicates this yearbook to Mr. Thomas A. Siwicki, the music director of the Paris City Schools.
