Thank you, Col. Leer, for stopping by M.M.I. on your journey of life.


No greater love hath a man than to lay down thirty years of his life for his country and give twenty years of his time working for the welfare and future of M.M.I.

Cadet Rose Wins MacArthur Award







**SENATOR MITCH McCONNELL
MMI COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER**

Born February 20, 1942, McConnell was reared in south Louisville, where he first put his leadership abilities to work as president of his high school's student body and National Honor Society member. He continued his record of outstanding scholarship and leadership at University of Louisville, where he served as student body president and was selected for "Who's Who Among American College and University Students" before graduating with honors in 1964. At the University of Kentucky Law School, he was elected president of the Student Bar Association.

Senator McConnell defeated two-term incumbent Walter D. Huddleston on November 6, 1984. McConnell's victory was by a 5,100 vote margin statewide. McConnell was the only Republican challenger in the nation to defeat a Democratic incumbent.

Senator McConnell was sworn into office January 3, 1985. That same week he was selected as the only freshman member to serve on the Intelligence Committee. Senator McConnell will also serve on the Judiciary and Agriculture Committees.

May they always shine with the warmth of his presence and the spirit of his love.






MMI ...

- 1893 Col. and Mrs. C. M. Best founded Millersburg Training School in buildings of Kentucky Wesleyan College.
- 1898 Became Millersburg Military Institute with the motto "Right Training is Better than Riches."
- 1920 Col. Best sold property to Bourbon County Board of Education.
- 1920 Seven citizens formed a stock company to continue MMI and bought "Forest Hill", home of Sanford Allen, built in 1851.
- 1921 Moffet Hall erected as dormitory and armory.
- 1927 State Basketball Champions
- 1931 MMI Board bought Millersburg Female College and established MMI Junior School.
- 1944 MMI became non-profit with perpetual charter.
- 1948 Board installed United States 55 C Reserve Officers Training Corps. Designated Honor School several years.
- 1976 15 April, Governor Carroll proclaimed MMI Day.
- 1977 MMI went co-educational for day students in January.
- 1979 MMI Junior School property sold
- 1984 MMI declared Official Military School of Kentucky.
- 1985 93rd year of operation.
