You're invited to the opening of our newest exhibit on June 9 from 2-4 PM. Hattie Hutchcraft Hill was born in Paris, Kentucky in 1847 and spent most of her life as a teacher and artist. She studied in France at the Academie Julian from 1888-1895 and operated a studio in Southern California from 1895-1898. She eventually returned home to Paris, Kentucky where she continued teaching and painting until her death in 1921. This exhibit will feature still lifes, seascapes, landscapes, gardenscapes, and portraits, as well as the works of a few of her students.
