Andrew Beck (1920-2010)

Andrew Franklin Beck was an artist, film editor, interior designer, and a Pearl Harbor veteran. He lived and worked for many years in California with his partner Henry Power Prichard, who was a songwriter. Beck and Prichard eventually returned to Prichard's hometown of Paris in the 1970s. They remained in Kentucky for the remainder of their lives. The Hopewell Museum has several of Beck's drawings, sketches and other artwork as part of Henry Power Prichard's estate collection. The examples of his art that we have are often vibrantly colored and in some cases turned into greeting cards that he would send to his friends.
